

Pupil Premium

We receive an allocation of money, separate from the school budget, called 'pupil premium'. This is a grant that provides support for our most vulnerable pupils; it supports children who are looked after or who are on free school meals and who need additional support. Our allocation for 2013/14 is £42,000.

Our pupil premium is used in the following ways:

- Additional teaching assistant support to work with target groups of pupils in English and Maths. Children follow specific intervention programmes. We monitor the progress of these groups through testing which takes place three times per year. Results of this form of intervention show that most of our pupils have made at or above expected progress in reading, writing and / or maths.
- Training for teaching assistants to enable effective delivery of the intervention work.
- Resources to support intervention work.
- To enable children to participate fully in the life of the school by giving access to extra-curricular activities, including support for the annual activity week where it is needed.
