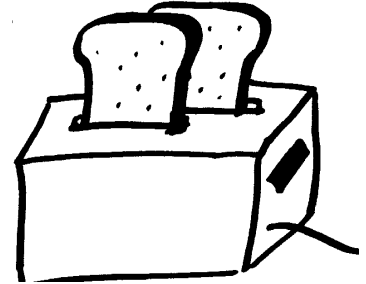


Toastie Tuesday
